

BBQ FOOD VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

A SIGNED COPY OF THIS MUST BE SENT IN WITH THE APPLICATION IN ORDER TO BE ACCEPTED AS A FOOD VENDOR

1. You must be a BBQ cook off contestant in order to be a BBQ food vendor no exceptions!
2. All fees must be paid by Thursday before the festival or you will not be allowed to set up your booth.
3. We in no way guarantee any amount of sells or foot traffic to your booth location.
4. Security is on site from Friday morning till Sunday morning for any problems however Beulahfest will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged equipment or goods.
5. R.V. spots are limited and are on a first come first serve bases (\$50 a night for full hook up)
6. All vendors are responsible for meeting the health code requirements, all vendors are subject to being inspected by a Health Dept. official at the festival.
7. All vendors that are frying anything must complete the fire code form found at <http://www.myescambia.com/Bureaus/CommunityServices/documents/Supplemental%20Information%20For%20Cooking%20Operations%20During%20Speci.pdf> and return with application. Vendors that do not meet these requirements need not apply for the food vendor side since this a non negotiable requirement set forth by the Escambia county fire inspection office
8. The Chairman has the final “say so” in any rule changes, dismissal actions, and monetary negotiations taking place at the festival or in the festivals name.
9. Failure to follow the above rules can result in immediate dismissal from the festival without a refund.
10. Vendors will be allowed to set up as early as Wednesday before the event and must be tore down and off the premises by Sunday.
11. You may only sell your BBQ items and sides as a vendor. We have other food vendors that cover all other aspects and we guarantee them no one else while sell there “main” dishes just like we guarantee no one outside the BBQ cook off area will sell any type of BBQ.
12. The selling of any types of beverages is strictly prohibited!
13. Any type of sabotage, fighting, or manipulating of the festival grounds will lead to immediate dismissal without a refund.
14. Have fun, be safe, enjoy our festival.

The following information is being provided to insure that all parties are aware and understand the requirements for cooking operations during special events. The information provided below is the minimum requirements as included in the Florida Fire Prevention Code FFPC (2007 Edition). These requirements will be subject to on-site inspection and review. Any deviations to minimum requirements shall only be allowed with the approval of the authority having jurisdiction.

10.11.2 Open Fires

- **10.11.3** Open fires and cooking fires shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished. This person shall have a garden hose connected to the water supply or other fire-extinguishing equipment readily available.

10.11.4 The AHJ shall have the authority to prohibit any or all open fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fire hazardous.

- **10.15 Special Outdoor Events, Carnivals, and Fairs**

10.15.2 The AHJ shall be permitted to regulate all outdoor events such as carnivals and fairs as it pertains to access for emergency vehicles; access to fire protection equipment; placement of stands, concession booths, and exhibits; and the control of hazardous conditions dangerous to life and property.

- **10.15.8 Cooking.** Concession stands utilized for cooking shall have a minimum of 10 ft (3 m) of clearance on two sides and shall not be located within 10 ft (3 m) of amusement rides or devices.

50.1.1* The design, installation, operation, inspection, and maintenance of all public and private commercial cooking equipment shall comply with this chapter and [NFPA 96](#), *Standard for Ventilation Control and Fire Protection of Commercial Cooking Operations*.

50.2.1.1 Cooking equipment used in processes producing smoke or grease laden vapors shall be equipped with an exhaust system that complies with all the equipment and performance requirements of this chapter. [96:4.1.1.2]

50.2.1.1.1 Cooking equipment that has been listed in accordance with UL 197, Standard for Commercial Electric Cooking Appliances, or an equivalent standard for reduced emissions shall not be required to be provided with an exhaust system [96:4.1.1.1]

50.2.1.9* Cooking equipment used in fixed, mobile, or temporary concessions, such as trucks, buses, trailers, pavilions, tents, or any form of roofed enclosure, shall comply with NFPA 96 or this chapter. [96:4.1.9]

Page 2 is required to be signed.

10.1.1 Fire-extinguishing equipment for the protection of grease removal devices, hood exhaust plenums, and exhaust duct systems shall be provided.

10.1.2* Cooking equipment that produces grease-laden vapors and that might be a source of ignition of grease in the hood, grease removal device, or duct shall be protected by fire-extinguishing equipment.

10.2.1 Fire-extinguishing equipment shall include both automatic fire-extinguishing systems as primary protection and portable fire extinguishers as secondary backup.
